

Guidelines for Election to Membership Chesterfield County Republican Committee

Determine the class of membership the candidate is seeking:
Precinct Membership or At Large Membership.

Candidates for Precinct Membership or At Large Membership may be nominated by any current member of the Chesterfield County Republican Committee at any duly called meeting of the County Committee.

Members shall serve a two year term or partial term depending on when within the biennium they were elected. Dues are payable each year.

Prior to nomination, the candidate must:

- a) Be present at a duly called meeting;
- b) Have completed an Application Form and submitted it to the Corresponding Secretary;
- c) Have tendered payment of the correct dues for the current year;
- d) A helpful option: Prepare a brief biography or a little history about yourself (one page), submit a copy to the Corresponding Secretary and your sponsor, who can share it with the Committee when you are introduced.

At the next duly called meeting, the candidate:

- a) Must be present;
- b) Be introduced and presented by his sponsor;
- c) Have his nomination properly seconded;
- d) Be elected by a majority of those members present and voting.

Each candidate must be present when he is nominated and at the next meeting when his nomination will be considered and voted upon. Each new member will be emailed a copy of the Chesterfield County Republican Committee Plan of Organization (Bylaws) and the Republican Party of Virginia Plan.
